### Resolution

#### Funding of President's Dinner

(Decided: [24/3/4])

#### Nature of the Problem:

In the past, the Office of Student Affairs used to convene the Cabinet of Student Leaders (COSL). As of today, this has not been done. As a result there has not been as much communication between various leaders of student organizations. This has led to decreased collaboration, as well as decreased dissemination of information.

#### Recommended Course of Action:

In order to once again bring back this tradition of Presidents meeting together, it is necessary that UPUA take the lead. Even when COSL existed, there was a dinner with Administrators and one with just students on an alternating basis. Some students took issue with COSL in that its membership was handpicked by whoever led Student Affairs at the time, most notably GSA was not invited to these meetings in recent years. By having UPUA fund the first dinner, outside of Student Affairs, the scope of leaders can be expanded upon, and it can be in student hands.

Be it Resolved that \$200 maximum be allocated from the Executive Board, in order to fund this first dinner on December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2008.
